

# Keyworker Homes



To qualify as a Keyworker, you must be employed in one of the following groups:

**Keyworkers are defined by the government and are those who are employed in frontline services essential to the welfare of the community such as health and education.**

As a Keyworker, you will find there are some specific properties available to rent for Keyworkers only. To apply for any Keyworker-specific home, whether that be to rent or to buy, you must apply to the local HomeBuy Agent.

In addition to being a Keyworker, there are some other basic qualifying criteria:

- You must be in permanent paid employment at the time of application. A fixed term contract is acceptable for Intermediate Rent. A written job offer is not sufficient.

**Please note:** The Keyworker definitions may change from time to time. Please enquire at the time of your application for a property.

- Health Workers - all clinical staff employed by the NHS (except doctors and dentists)
- Teachers (including FE Teachers)
- Police Officers (operational and operational support staff)
- Prison Officers (and some prison service staff)
- Probation Officers, Senior Probation Officers and Probation Service Officers (Trainee Probation Officers for Intermediate Rent only)
- LA and NHS Social Workers
- LA Occupational Therapists
- LA Educational Psychologists
- LA Planners
- LA Speech and Language Therapists
- LA employed clinical staff (e.g. Nurses)
- Rehabilitation Officers for the visually impaired
- Qualified Nursery Nurses (employed by an LEA or NHS Trust)
- Uniformed Staff in Fire and Rescue Services
- Connexions Personal Advisors
- Armed Forces Personnel
- Environmental Health Officers / Practitioners
- Traffic Officer Staff of the Highways Agency Traffic Officer Service
